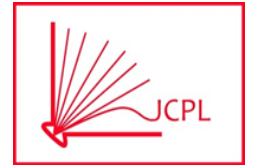

Read a book ...

- 2) ... written by an author you've never read before.
- 3) ... about a conspiracy theory.
- 4) ... written by a local author.
- 5) ... set in a hotel.
- 6) ... written by a person of color.
- 7) ... of poems.
- 8) ... with less than 150 pages.
- 9) ... with a character that has your name or a nickname you go by.
- 10) ... based on a true story.
- 11) ... with a RED spine.
- 12) ... written by or about a former or current United States president.
- 13) ... set during a holiday that IS NOT Christmas!
- 14) ... from the non-fiction section about an unsolved murder or crime.
- 15) ... about an immigrant or a refugee.
- 16) ... with pictures!
- 17) ... based on or about mythology.
- 18) ... with a month or day of the week in the title.
- 19) ... written by a female author.
- 20) ... that has made you cry before.
- 21) ... that you loved as a child.
- 22) ... that you totally judged based on the cover. (This means no reading the inside or of the book!)
- 23) ... that discusses slavery. (Fiction or non-fiction.)
- 24) ... that is a classic story from a different point of view.
- 25) ... from the Graphic Novel section. (Comic books and mangas count!)
