Read a book ...

- 1) ... from the 630s-640s section in the Non-Fiction Section.
- 2) ... about a scientist from the Biography or Non-Fiction section.
- 3) ... with an animal in the title.
- 4) ... that is set in, or about space.
- 5) ... from the Biography Section.
- 6) ... set in a library.
- 7) ... you randomly chose! (No peeking at the book summary!!)
- 8) ... about a farmer.
- 9) ... you think sounds boring. It's okay to complain about it, too!
- 10) ... about a Native American tribe or specific Native American.
- 11) ... or actually, a magazine. (Ask a staff member for help locating one if you are unfamiliar with where the J-Magazines are.)
- 12) ... picked out by a librarian.
- 13) ... in the 590s of the Non-Fiction Section.
- 14) ... with a PINK spine.
- 15) ... that is most definitely scary.
- 16) ... that is full of science experiments!
- 17) ... based on or about dinosaurs.
- 18) ... about gardening.
- 19) ... about a foreign culture.
- 20) ... about a unicorn.
- 21) ... that you judged based on the title. (No reading about the book before you choose!)
