This packet is for active participants, full of information about each upcoming program and fun things to do – color sheets and puzzles - to earn entries into the drawing for prizes.

Tuesday, June 7, 2022 at 6pm, we will discuss the **Atlantic Ocean** and its largest inhabitant the **Blue Whale**. While making a painted sign out of simple paint stir sticks, we will visit the wreckage of the RMS Titanic deep below the depths of the Atlantic Ocean.

Tuesday, June 14, 2022 at 6pm, we will discuss the **Pacific Ocean** and its main inhabitant the **Sea Turtle**. While making beautiful sea shell covered napkin rings, we will visit an underwater post office in the waters of Japan and Jellyfish Lake in Palau.

Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at 6pm, we will discuss the **Indian Ocean** and one of its important inhabitants the **Dugong**. While recreating a marbled look on coffee mugs, we will visit an undersea restaurant in Maldiva.

Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 6pm, we will discuss the **Arctic Ocean** and one of its main inhabitants, the **Polar Bear**. We will play a game of Ocean Trivia for a chance to win a prize and begin a craft of painting animal portraits either of your pet or an adorable ocean animal.

Tuesday, July 5, 2022 at 6pm, we will discuss the **Antarctic Ocean** and one of its main inhabitants, the **Emperor Penguin**. While finishing up our animal portraits with watercolors, we will discuss the hazards of some cleaning products on the ocean and get recipes of cleansers you can make yourself, which are safe alternatives.
