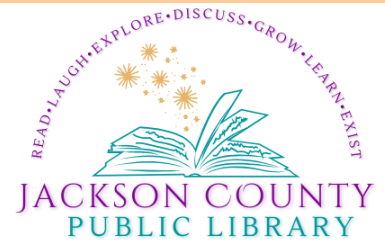

Read a book...

- 1) ... from the 001 part of the Non-Fiction Section.
- 2) ... about the night sky.
- 3) ... with a cityscape on the cover.
- 4) ... that is set in, or about a forest.
- 5) ... that was written the year you turned 5. (Ask us at the front desk, if you need help!)
- 6) ... set in a library.
- 7) ... you randomly chose! (No peeking!!)
- 8) ... about survival.
- 9) ... you think sounds boring. It's okay to complain about it, too!
- 10)... about a trailblazing woman,
- 11)... or actually, a magazine. (Ask a staff member for help locating one if you are unfamiliar with where the J-Magazines are.)
- 12)... picked out by a librarian.
- 13)... in the 590s of the Non-Fiction Section.
- 14)... with a GREEN cover.
- 15)... that will be a movie this year!
- 16)... that is about cryptids!
- 17)... with or about dinosaurs.
- 18)... with a main character whose name starts with the letter F.
